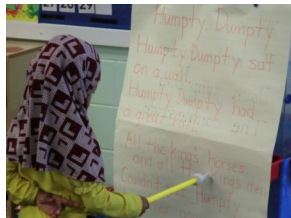
The past few weeks we have been learning more structured games outside, like “Red Light, Green Light.” We also have found several creative ways to share the hula hoops.
