## **Important Information:**

- Students must check in to their afterschool club space between 3:00–3:15. Students may leave their activity early, but need to leave or be picked up by 5:00PM.
- Parents and Guardians, if you arrive early, please do not enter the building to pick up your student! Please call or text (802) 316–1454 to let the Program Coordinator know you have arrived, and your student will meet you outside the main entrance.
- Students may only attend in-person activities if they were in school in person that day.
- Students may not leave the HMS campus between dismissal and afterschool. Anyone who leaves campus will not be allowed to come to afterschool that day.
