

Fostering Consistent Engagement in School

As we enter into our third year of this successful pilot program, we highlight the incredible work that our Outreach team has done among local middle school students who are, or are at risk of being chronically absent. The SHCC Outreach Program started in the Spring of 2021 as students began returning to school during the Covid-19 pandemic, a program that initially began to solely help reengage young people. Over the last two years the program has adapted based on the needs of the students, transitioning into a mentorship model that connects adventure learning and vocational opportunities to youth facing various adversities, with the goal of fostering consistent, successful school engagement.
