Hello Families!

Thank you for your interest in the Middle School Afterschool Program! Afterschool clubs and activities meet on school days from dismissal until 5:00pm unless otherwise noted. Below is a list of clubs and activities available to all **registered** participants.

Important Information:

- Students report to the cafeteria after school (supper will be available!) Staff will check students in and club instructors will walk them to their after-school club space. **Note: for Teen Center Drop In, students will have an optional supervised walk or can go directly to the Miller Center.**
- Students may leave their activity early, but need to leave or be picked up by 5:00PM (Wednesdays by 4:00PM) unless other noted.
- Parents and Guardians, if you arrive early, please do not enter the building to pick up your student. Please call or text (802) 316-1454 to let the Program Coordinator know you have arrived, and your student will meet you outside the main entrance.
- Students may only attend after-school activities if they were in school that day.
- Students must arrive to program by 3:15PM or communicate with Coordinator.

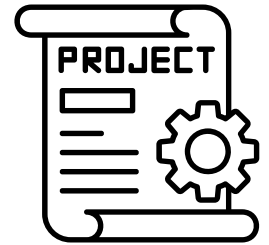

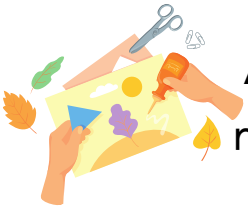
Spring Session Programs and Clubs

Coding Club @ HMS: Interested in knowing more about how coding works and what you can build? Come learn the basics of coding using Python Programming Language!



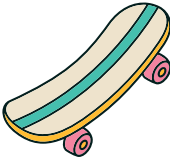
