## **Important Information:**

- Students report to the cafeteria after school (supper will be available!) Staff will check students in and club instructors will walk them to their after-school club space.
- Students may leave their activity early, but need to leave or be picked up by 5:00PM.
- Parents and Guardians, if you arrive early, please do not enter the building to pick up your student! Please call or text (802) 316-1454 to let the Program Coordinator know you have arrived, and your student will meet you outside the main entrance.
- Students may only attend in-person activities if they were in school in person that day.
- Students may not leave the HMS campus between dismissal and after-school. Anyone who leaves campus will not be allowed to come to after-school that day.
